## Eleventh Station - Jesus is Nailed to the Cross

V: We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You. Â Â Adoremus te, Christe, et benedicimus tibi.

R: Because, by Your holy cross, You have redeemed the world.  $\hat{A} \ \hat{A} \ \hat{A}$  Quia per sanctam crucem tuam redemisti mundum.

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V: Consider Jesus, thrown down upon the cross, He stretched out His arms and offered to His eternal Father the sacrifice of His life for our salvation. They nailed His hands and feet, and then, raising the cross, left Him to die in anguish.

R: My despised Jesus,

- Â Â I love You more than myself;
- ÂÂÂ I am sorry for ever having offended You.
- Â Â Never permit me to offend You again.
- $\hat{A} \hat{A} \hat{A}$  Grant that I may love You always; and then do with me as You will.
