V: We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You. Â Â Â Adoremus te, Christe, et benedicimus tibi.

R: Because, by Your holy cross, You have redeemed the world. \hat{A} \hat{A} Quia per sanctam crucem tuam redemisti mundum.

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V: Consider how Jesus, after three hours of agony on the cross, is finally overwhelmed with suffering and, abandoning Himself to the weight of His body, bows His head and dies.

R: My dying Jesus,

Â Î devoutly kiss the cross on which You would die for love of me.

Â Î deserve, because of my sins, to die a terrible death;

Â Â but Your death is my hope.

Â Â By the merits of Your death,

Â Â give me the grace to die embracing Your feet and burning with love of You.
