- V: We adore You, O Christ, and we praise You. Â Â Adoremus te, Christe, et benedicimus tibi.
- R: Because, by Your holy cross, You have redeemed the world. $\hat{A} \hat{A} \hat{A}$ Quia per sanctam crucem tuam redemisti mundum.

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V: Consider how, after Our Lord has died, He was taken down from the cross by two of His disciples, Joseph and Nocodemus, and placed in the arms of His afflicted Mother. She received Him with unutterable tenderness and pressed Him close to her bosom.

R: O Mother of Sorrows,
