At 57 years of age she founded the Presentation Sisters to carry on the work of her 7 schools in the city. Today, her followers number thousands and continue her work worldwide. In an RTE radio poll in 2005 she was voted the Most Influential Irish Woman of all time.

## From darkness to light

In all the Easter work of Jesus,  
he led the disciples

out of darkness into light,
